THIS IS A FOUR-SEMESTER PROGRAM

Nova SBE students spend the **1st semester at Nova SBE** and the **2nd, 3rd and 4th semesters at NYU**. Semester 4 will be to develop the Work Project and Capstone Experience.

Degree awarded at Nova SBE: MSc in Management or International MSc in Management

Degree awarded at NYU Tandon: MSc in Management of Technology

Number of slots 10 slots from Nova SBE to NYU

Selection Nova SBE selects its own students. Requirement of minimum BSc's degree GPA: 3.5 out of 4.

GMAT/GRE: Optional

IMPORTANT NOTE: Students **must achieve grade B** in Nova SBE courses to transfer them to the NYU degree. Only a maximum number of 9 NYU credits can be transferred.

To be awarded the Nova SBE degree, students must complete a minimum of 90 ECTS. Therefore, some courses taken at NYU can be accredited towards the Nova SBE Master's degree to reach that minimum.

Language of Instruction at Partner School

English | Candidates must achieve a minimum TOEFL score of 90 on the internet-based test, an overall band of 7.0 on IELTS, a 65 on the Pearson PTE Academics exam, a C1 Advanced or C2 Proficiency on the Cambridge Assessment English exam or a 125 minimum score on the Duolingo English Test.
